

City Council Minutes
Regular Meeting
February 6, 1980

The City Council met in a regular scheduled Council meeting in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall Building, February 6, 1980 at 7:30 o'clock P.M. Mayor Deitrich presided with the following Councilmen present: J. Seip, Van Fleet, Aldrich, Butler, Kerr, H. Seip.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that the minutes of the regular meeting of January 16, 1980 be approved as presented. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

The 1980-1981 Budget hearing was open to the Public at 7:30 O'clock P.M. There being no written or Oral objections to the published budget, at 8:30 o'clock P.M. the budget was duly adopted by Resolution 2-6-80.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that the Resolution adopting the 1980-1981 budget be approved. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman J. Seip that the Resolution to erect a stop sign at the intersection of Ringgold Street and North Main street, stopping westbound traffic on Ringgold Street be approved. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous. A Copy of this resolution being made a part of these minutes.

Councilman Butler made the motion, seconded by Councilman Aldrich that Mr. Z's Beer and Liquor licenses renewals be approved, as all the necessary papers were in order. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous. The Council requested that an ad be run in the Sigourney News Review for Pool manager.

Councilman Van Fleet made the motion, seconded by Councilman Kerr that the City accept the bid from Century Motors for a 1980 1/2 Ton Chevrolet pickup for the Water Dept. in the amount of \$4,913.15. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that this new pickup for the Water Dept. be paid for with money transferred out of Revenue Sharing. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Jim Baker, representative of the Mahaska Farm Service Co. and Russell Veach were present at the Council meetin in regard to the moving of the DX bulk plant they have purchased on North main to their place of business on South Main or Highway 149 outside the City limits.

Changes in the Water Dept. work schedule as follows: one man work Monday thru Friday, the other man would work Tuesday thru Saturday plus Sunday, alternating every other week.




