

CITY OF SIGOURNEY  
REGULAR COUNCIL MINUTES  
February 20, 1985  
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The City Council met in a regular scheduled council meeting in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall on February 20, 1985 at 7:30 O'clock P.M. as posted and published. Mayor Deitrich presided with the following Councilmen answering roll call. Garringer, Aldrich, Butler, Kerr, H. Seip, J. Seip.

At 7:30 O'clock P.M. Mayor Deitrich stated the budget hearing for the 1985-86 fiscal year was now open to the public as advertised.

Carroll Wood, James Stout, Lyle Van Fleet, Rob Marget, Oz Cellman, Tom Siskow, Ken Bucklin were present at the Council meeting. James Stout and Carroll Wood were present to ask the Mayor and Council about putting in a new water line down south Stuart St. so they could hook up to the new line. Nothing was done at this time.

Dow Sat requested the City return their performance bond. Councilman Kerr made the motion, seconded by Councilman Butler that this be tabled until after the City Attorney checks on this. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Greenbows were discussed and it was decided that these could not be put on any City property.

Councilman Garringer made the motion, seconded by Councilman Kerr that John Tremmel and Don Adams both be reappointed to the Sigourney Planning and Zoning Commission for the next five years with their terms expiring in February 1990. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Butler that the City purchase the new Sharp SF-756 Photo Copier Machine from M & M Sales Co. for the price of \$1495.00 with the City keeping our old Minolta Copy machine. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman Garringer made the motion, seconded by Councilman H. Seip that Kind's Jack and Jill's beer license renewal be approved as all necessary papers were in order. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Mayor Deitrich went over the Community Development Block Grant papers that the City received. This Grant being in the amount of \$300,000 with the City matching this amount with \$335,000 making the total of \$635,000 for upgrading the East Treatment plant.

Councilman Garringer made the motion, seconded by Councilman J. Seip that French-Reneker Associates be hired to work with the Mayor and Councilmen during the design and construction of this sewage treatment improvement project. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

The Sigourney Planning and Zoning Commission members, Tom Siskow, Lyle Van Fleet, Rob MARGET, OZ Cellman were present and will be giving the City a letter stating they are in agreement of the City upgrading the East Treatment Plant facility.

There were no oral or written objectors to the 1985-1986 Budget. A copy from L. E. Williamson, President of the Keokuk County Agency on Aging is being made a part of these minutes.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Kerr that the 1985-1986 budget be approved as published. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

There being no further business to come before the meeting upon motion, meeting adjourned in form.
