REGULAR COUNCIL MINUTES

March 20, 1985

The City Council met in a regular scheduled Council meeting in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall on March 20, 1985 at 7:30 O'clock P.M. as posted and published. Mayor Deitrich presided at the meeting with the following Councilman answering roll call: Aldrich, Butler, H. Seip, J. Seip, and Garringer. Absent: Councilman Kerr.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Butler that the minutes of the regular meeting of March 6, 1985 be approved as corrected. Upon roll call the following voted: Ayes: Aldrich, Butler, H. Seip, J. Seip, Garringer. Nays: None.

The City Clerk's and City Treasurer's Monthly reports were before the Mayor and Council.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Aldrich that the City purchase 2 ZX 400 SHARP Typewriters for the City Clerk's Office. The Cost of \$795.00 each; total for both \$1590.00 minus \$196.00 less on each machine or \$1,198.00 less trade in on the Adler of \$75.00 and \$5.00 for the Smith Corona making the City's price \$1118.00 for the 2 machines, with the City having the option of a maintenance agreement anytime. Upon roll call the following voted: Ayes: Aldrich, Butler, H. Seip, J. Seip, Garringer. Nays: None.

Councilman Garringer made the motion, seconded by Councilman J. Seip that Beth Hollingsworth be hired as manager and Stefany Deitrich assistant manager for the 1985 Swimming Pool Season. Upon roll call the following voted: Ayes: Aldrich, Butler, H. Seip, J. Seip, Garringer. Nays: None.

The remaining pool help will be hired at the next regular Council meeting.

Jim Fry was present at the Council meeting in regards to his mowing at the park and having the door on the mower shed enlarged if he purchases a new mower.

Councilman Garringer made the motion, seconded by Councilman Butler that the resolution from the joint meeting of the American Legion Post and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post appointing John Wilkening to the unexpired term of Mr. E. C. "Jim" Beverlin on the Memorial Hall Commission be approved. Upon roll call the vote was as follows: Ayes: Aldrich, Butler, H. Seip, J. Seip, Garringer. Nays: None.

It was suggested that the City Attorney get a letter off to Howard Burch in regard to getting our waterline extension finished.

There being no further business to be brought before the Council upon motion meeting adjourned in form.
