A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF STUART STREET AND THE ALLEY ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF LOTS ONE AND FOUR IN BLOCK TWO OF THE ORIGINAL PLAT TO THE CITY OF SIGOURNEY, KEOKUK COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sigourney, Iowa finds that a dangerous intersection exists at the intersection of Stuart Street and the alley on the south side of Lots One and Four in Block Two of the Original Plat to the City of Sigourney, Keokuk County, Iowa; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sigourney, Iowa desires to establish a stop sign at the above mentioned intersection to stop east-bound traffic in order to provide for public safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sigourney, Iowa that there shall be established a stop sign at the intersection of Stuart Street and the alley on the south side of Lots One and Four in Block Two of the Original Plat to the City of Sigourney, Keokuk County, Iowa to stop east-bound traffic, and that the Police Department shall erect the appropriate sign giving notice thereof.
