

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SEPT. 3, 1980

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The City Council met in a regular scheduled Council meeting in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall Building Sept. 3, 1980 at 7:30 O'clock P.M. as posted and published.

Mayor Deitrich presided with the following Councilmen answering roll call: Aldrich, Butler, Kerr, H. Seip, J. Seip, Van Fleet.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that the minutes of the regular meeting of August 20, 1980 be approved as presented. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman Kerr made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that the Resolution on changing the Stop sign to Stopping the East West traffic on Elm and Laffer be approved. Upon roll call the vote was as follows:

Councilman Van Fleet made the motion, seconded by Councilman H. Seip that the Street Supt. be given permission to order 20 Ton of Salt from Cargill for salting streets this winter. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Kerr that the resolution 9-3-80 which is made a part of these minutes be approved. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that the City Insurance specs be sent to the insurance agents in town with the opening date of the Insurance bids to be Oct. 1, 1980 at 8:00 O'clock P.M. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sigourney, Keokuk County, Iowa as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sigourney, Iowa has the authority, under Ordinance No. 294 passed the 18th day of January, A.D., 1978, to establish new traffic regulations by the placement of traffic and parking signs through the passage of a resolution by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that there is a problem with the present traffic regulations at the intersection of Laffer Street and Elm Street; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Sigourney, Iowa for the City Council to establish stop signs at the intersection of Laffer Street and Elm Street, stopping east-west traffic on Elm Street, and remove the stop signs now posted at said intersection stopping north-south traffic on Laffer Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sigourney, Iowa that stop signs shall be erected by the Street Superintendent, under the supervision of the Police Department, to stop east-west traffic on Elm Street at the intersection of Laffer Street and Elm Street, and the present stop signs stopping north-south traffic on Laffer Street shall be removed.
