

City Council Minutes

The City Council met in a regular scheduled Council meeting September 17, 1980 at 7:30 O'clock P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall Building. Mayor Deitrich presided with the following Councilmen present: Aldrich, Butler, Kerr, H. Seip, J. Seip & Van Fleet.

Councilman Van Fleet made the motion, seconded by Councilman Butler that the minutes of the regular meeting of September 3, 1980 be approved as presented. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Max Wilkening was before the Council and asked if they could get an extension on the time to clean up the John Wilkening property. Councilman Van Fleet made the motion, seconded by Councilman Butler that he be given until the 15th of October so this would give them plenty of time. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that Oz Cellman be paid \$388.90 for mileage for trips made while serving on the Area Xv Multi County Housing Agency. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that permission be given for the Circus parade around the square. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman H. Seip made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that ~~the subject of August Bower driveway be tabled at this time.~~ Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.

Councilman Kerr made the motion, seconded by Councilman Van Fleet that the no parking Resolution on Ringgold Street be marked so that there be no parking on the north side of Ringgold St. As per Resolution being made a part of these minutes. Upon roll call the vote was unanimous.
