

CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
November 20, 1985

The City Council met in a regular scheduled Council meeting in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall Building on November 20, 1985 at 7:30 O'clock P.M. as posted and published. Mayor Deitrich presided with the following Councilmen present: Kerr, H. Seip, J. Seip, Garringer, Aldrich, Butler.
