## CITY OF SIGOURNEY, IOWA REGULAR COUNCIL MÉETING WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 3, 1986

The Sigourney City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers of the Memorial Hall on Wednesday, December 3, 1986 at 7:30 o'clock p.m., as posted. Mayor Deitrich presided at the meeting with the following Councilmen answering roll call: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, and J. Seip. Also present was Barb Drake, correspondent for The Ottumwa Courier.

Councilman Park moved, seconded by Councilman Clawson, that the minutes of the meeting of November 19, 1986 be approved as submitted. Upon the roll being called, the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, and J. Nays: None Seip.

Councilman H. Seip introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

## RESOLUTION 12-3-86

BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Sigourney, IA will submit an application to the Iowa 1987 Community Development Block Grant Program to improve the west sewer facility and to correct the sewer problems now existing within the City of Sigourney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Sigourney hereby commits funds in the amount of \$330,000.00, with  $\mathbf{Amended}$ the source thereof being revenue bonds.

12-17-86 To \$190,000

The motion was seconded by Councilman Clawson and upon the roll being called, the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, and J. Seip. Nays: None. (For the record, it should be noted, however, that in the discussion before the voting the Mayor and Council all felt that the figure of \$330,000 was higher than the proposed \$150-200,000, with a potential grant being \$300,000. This figure of \$630,000 total construction cost came from Dave Fredricks of French-Reneker-Associates through Dale Kraus. It was the consensus of the Council that the figure was overstated and that it was probably taken from the engineers' calculations sometime back when the preliminaries were done for the Consolidated Foods industry, but they would be agreeable to committing \$330,000, with the hope that it actually would be much less.)

The Blue Cross-Blue Shield January 1st billing increase was The matter was referred to the Finance Committee discussed. and it was decided that they would meet with all employees covered (tomorrow night, December 4, 1986, at 7:00 p.m.)

Councilman Clawson moved that the following fund transfers be made to the General Fund to reimburse for sewer lagoon expenditures:

\$10,683.80 from Federal Revenue to General Fund for Capital Outlay funds used in the sewer lagoon project \$60,000.00 from Sewer Utility to General Capital Outlay \$10,000.00 from Road Use Tax to General, which would be the approximate cost of roadways at the new lagoon project paid for from Capital Outlay funds in the General Fund

Councilman J. Seip seconded the motion, and upon the roll being called, the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Sein, and J. Sein, Nays: None Nays: None H. Seip, and J. Seip.

Councilman Park moved, seconded by Councilman Kerr, that the offer of Dr. Puangtong Jutabha to donate the former (old) Dick's Corner building to the City of Sigourney be rejected. The motion was seconded by Councilman Kerr and upon the roll being called the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, and J. Seip. Nays: None

Councilman H. Seip moved that the street construction program proposed last year be adopted and submitted and resolved again to the Department of Transportation, Road Use Tax Fund department, as our Street Construction Program for the next fiscal year. The motion-resolution was seconded by Councilman Park. Upon the roll being called the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, J. Seip. Nays: None

Councilman Clawson moved, seconded by Councilman H. Seip, that the Keokuk County State Bank be designated as the depositary for Economic Development Administration (EDA) funds for project No. 05-01-02224, Louis Rich Rural Water. Upon the roll being called, the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, and J. Seip. Nays: None

Councilman Kerr moved that the claims be allowed as submitted. The motion was seconded by Councilman Park. Upon the roll being called, the following voted: Ayes: Butler, Clawson, Kerr, Park, H. Seip, J. Seip, Nays: None

The meeting adjourned in due form at 8:10 p.m.
